First Eucharist at St. Leo's Church

Grade 2 children of St. Louis School have been preparing for first Eucharist. They will receive the Sacrament next Sunday April 26th @ the 11:30 am Mass. First Communion is a momentous experience and a very solemn moment in the lives of our young people. We join the immediate family in the youngster's celebration of this event as they are joining us at *our* family table: the table of God's family.

Ten Commandments of Church Manners

1. Arrive on time for the Celebration of Mass.
2. Turn off cellular phones before entering the Church. Do not bring computer games to Church!
3. Do not chew gum in Church. (Communion Fast is one hour prior to receiving Communion.) This includes gum!
4. GENUFLECT: When entering the pew before Mass starts and exiting the pew after Mass has ended. Show respect for the blessed Eucharist present in the Tabernacle.

5. When children are restless, take them to the lobby or to the back of the Church.
6. "Look" to where the action is on the Altar - priest, readers etc.
7. Sing and pray with *ENTHUSIASM!*
8. When receiving Holy Communion, consume the host immediately - do not walk away with it.
9. Remain in your pew until the final procession reaches the back of the Church.
10. After Mass is completed, say a prayer.
