

Day of Midian

Isaiah predicts a victory for God's people. It will be a time of "a great light" which the Church connects with Christmas. Isaiah compares it with a famous battle of the past. Midian was a region of northern Arabia. Moses had lived peacefully with them—even marrying a Midianite woman Zipporah. During the time of the Judges c. 1225-1100 B.C. Midian raiding parties had wreaked havoc on Israel. One Judge, Gideon, won a decisive victory—here referred to as "The Day of Midian." (Lonsdale Commentaries & Clip-Art)
