Ten Commandments of Church Manners

1. Arrive on time for the Celebration of Mass.
2. Turn off cellular phones before entering the Church. Do not bring computer games to Church!
3. Do not chew gum in Church. (Communion Fast is one hour prior to receiving Communion.) This includes gum!
4. GENUFLECT: When entering the pew before Mass starts and exiting the pew after Mass has ended. Show respect for the blessed Eucharist present in the Tabernacle.
5. When children are restless, take them to the back of the Church.
6. “Look” to where the action is on the Altar – priest, readers etc.
7. Sing and pray with **ENTHUSIASM!**
8. When receiving Holy Communion, consume the host immediately – do not walk away with it.
9. Remain in your pew until the final procession reaches the back of the Church.
10. After Mass is completed, say a prayer

Dieci Comandamenti di buona Educazione in Chiesa

1. Arrivare in tempo per la celebrazione della Messa.

3. Non si mastica gomma in Chiesa (il digiuno e minimo un'ora prima di ricevere la comunione), questo include la gomma.
4. INGINOCCHIARSI. Quando si entra nei banchi e quando si esce. Dimostrare rispetto per il Santissimo presente nel Tabernacolo.
5. Quando i bambini sono agitati, portarli all'ingresso della Chiesa o dietro il più possibile.
6. Osservare cosa sta succedendo sull'altare – parroco, lettori etc.
7. Cantare e pregare con **ENTUSIASMO**.
8. Nel ricevere la Comunione, consumare l'Ostia immediatamente, non portarla nei banchi camminando con essa.
9. Rimanere nei banchi finché la processione finale raggiunge la parte posteriore della Chiesa.
10. Dopo che la Messa è finita dire una preghiera.
