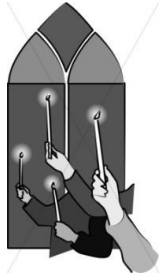

2017 Sunday Envelopes - Last Call

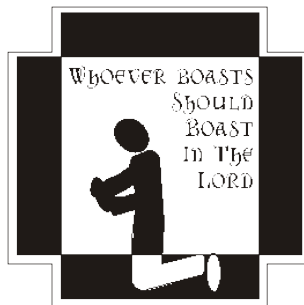

All parents/guardians must register their child at the Parish Office in order to request any Sacraments for their child. Registration must be done in person anytime during office hours. The parish office is offering extended registration office hours on Monday February 27th and Monday March 6th the office will remain open until 7:00 pm the closing date for registration is Friday, March 24th at noon. Late registration may mean that child's reception of the Sacraments will be postponed till the following year.
