Lo Stemma Papale

È tradizione, da almeno otto secoli, per vescovi, cardinali e per pontefici di adottare uno stemma araldico. Dal Rinascimento in poi, con questo stemma sono decorati i monumenti e le opere fatte edificare dal Papa, oltre che i documenti da lui scritti. Uno stemma, come si sa, si compone di uno scudo, segue regole di composizione, vi si pone intorno simboli ed insegne di carattere ecclesiastico e religioso, è circondato da elementi, che indicano la dignità, il grado, il titolo, la giurisdizione, ecc. Spesso i Papi adottavano lo scudo della propria famiglia, se esso esisteva, oppure componevano uno scudo con simbolismi che indicavano una propria idealità di vita, un riferimento a fatti o esperienze passate.
