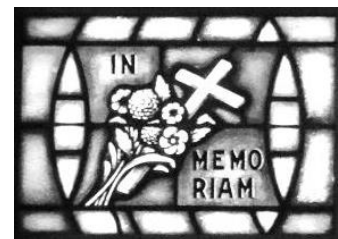

Requesting a Mass to be offered

The Church considers the Mass the greatest possible prayer of intercession because it is the perfect offering of Christ to the Father by making present the Paschal Mystery of His death and resurrection. Parishioners may request to offer a Mass for a specific intention even if one cannot be physically present at the Mass; it can be for the living or for the dead or for a special occasion. The faithful make a free will offering, called a stipend, in order to apply the Mass to their own specific intention. By the making this offering, the faithful, associate themselves more intimately with Christ who offers Himself in the Sacred Host. Mass offering can be scheduled by stopping in or calling the parish office. The stipend is \$20.00 per Mass.
