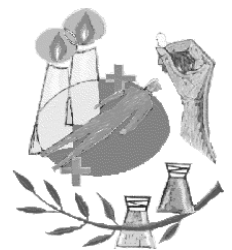
First-Fruits

Paul teaches the doctrine of Original Sin. The sins of the first humans established a hereditary corruption in society. Jesus reversed this pattern by his obedience to his Father. Paul likens it to a harvest. Hebrews reserved the earliest plants—or "First Fruits" as sacrifices for God.
