A good example of this is the attitude of the Bible towards a pagan king from Iran. The Jews had been conquered by an invader from Iraq in the beginning of the 6th century B.C. The prophets told them to expect a savior who would bring them freedom. In 549 Cyrus II (known as the Great) king of Iran, conquered Iraq. He was a shrewd politician and freed all the former slaves. 
Come & See Weekend
