

### **Demanding Interest**

A few people have more goods or money than they need for their personal survival. A common practice from ancient times has been to lend wealth to someone else with hope of a return. This was a serious issue in the bible. Scripture taught that it was immoral to charge interest. It was condemned as "usury". Loans could be made as charitable acts. The loaner could request a pledge or bond that the money be repaid. The first reading teaches that pledges could not be kept from the owner in dire need. A cloak could be taken, but must be returned at night. In the Middle Ages, the term usury was applied to excessive interest. Rulers fixed rates, but individual terms could still make extreme demands privately. (Lonsdale Commentaries & Clip Art)
