The Vengeful

Revenge could be extreme in biblical times. A mere slight or insult might bring maiming and even death. God tried to limit this in the Old Testament by limiting vengeance to "an eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth, a life for a



life." (Ex 21:24) This may seem uncharitable by Christian teaching, but people had to be brought along slowly. Toward the end of the Old Testament period, the elderly religion teachers showed a more current attitude; they taught that revenge in any form was contrary to the law of God.
