We begin what is called "Ordinary time" in the Church calendar. Ordinary does not mean plain or simple. It means "numbered" as in first, second, etc. the ordinal numbers. This was the original sense of the word, this title has come to represent a less spectacular or more "average" period in Church celebrations. The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord (Jan 8) officially brings the Christmas Season to a close. The numbers are meant to remind us that we are working toward a goal. The theme announced by His Holiness Pope Francis for the 2018 World Day of Migrants and Refugees is "Welcoming, Protecting, Promoting and Integrating Migrants and Refugees". In his message, Pope Francis reminds us that "every stranger who knocks at our door is an opportunity for an encounter with Jesus Christ, who identifies with the welcomed and rejected strangers of every age..." A special Mass commemorating the 104th World Day of Migrants and Refugees will be celebrated this Sunday, January 14 at 1 pm at the Good Shepherd Chaldean Catholic Cathedral, located at 2 High Meadow Place in North York. Bishop Wayne Kirkpatrick will be the homilist.

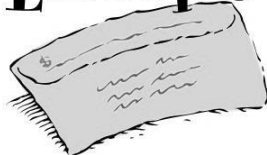
School Mass
