About envelopes use:

Please keep in mind the following when preparing your envelope for offering:

- Write the amount offered on the envelope
- Avoid packing your envelope with too many coins, they fall out and rip the envelope seal.
- Please do not use any kind of tape to seal the envelope.
- Please try to avoid post-dated cheques, unless absolutely necessary, our money counters don't necessarily look at the date on cheques; at times postdated cheques get deposited and returned by the bank causing a lot of confusion.
