

**A Little Yeast**

If you've ever used a bread making machine or fixed bread by hand, you know what yeast does. It makes the dough rise and soft. We usually get yeast from the supermarket in cake or dried form. Bread makers in the bible didn't have this luxury. They had to make their own yeast. Here's how: They would begin with a batch of slightly moist flour. Then they would cover it with cloth and leave it in a warm spot. Yeast is a microscopic plant that is in the air all around us. Eventually the yeast would start growing in the wet flour. After a few days it would give off a pungent aroma and turn gray. This all took some time, so normally they would save a bit of "starter" batch to speed up the process. We call bread made from this natural yeast "sourdough". Once a year, at Passover time, they would throw out all the old yeast to start fresh. During this time they would eat yeast-less or "unleavened" bread. Saint Paul uses this image to teach that Christians have to throw out their old attitudes and ways of living. These could spread in us just like bad yeast. We must live new risen lives with Jesus. (Father Lonsdale Commentaries & Art-Clip)
