


When Did The Spirit Come?

Update from St Leo's St Vincent de Paul

As of the end of April we've made 42 home visits to 34 different households. We've helped 46 adults and 18 children with food, furniture and clothing. We've distributed \$2,010 in food assistance. We have also registered 6 children for summer camp at the St Vincent de Paul camps. During this time the poor box collections total \$2,249. On behalf of the families we've visited, thank you for your generosity! Please remember to pray for the needs of these families as they deal with various health and family issues. God bless you.
