### Real Presence

"The medicine of Immortality" was how St. Ignatius of Antioch referred to the Eucharist while St. Thomas Aquinas considered it to be the greatest of all sacraments. On this day Catholics honor the "Real Presence" in the Eucharist, food for our soul. The Eucharist, that mystery that is meant to plunge its roots deeply into every area of our lives and it unfolds into daily encounter with a living God, who calls us to continual conversion. This conversion happens in and through the very "stuff" of the struggles and travail of our daily lives; through the mistakes, the wrong choices, the failures, and even through the pain. Through it all, most often in difficulty the love of God purifies and refines us. We experience Jesus most personally and intimately when we receive Him- body, blood, soul, and divinity - in the Holy Eucharist. The Feast of Corpus Christi is an invitation to honor in a most special way this great gift to be received and lived.



### Celebrating Senior's Month

June is senior's Month. Current demographics indicate that senior adults are beginning to outnumber the younger generation and are living 20 to 30 years longer than previous generations. Did you know that there are 900 million persons in the world over the age of 60 and in Canada, there are more people over the age of 65 than children under the age of 15? Life expectancy has increased by 30 years over the past 100 years and our potential for spiritual growth increases as we age. Seniors constitute a new generation. The maturing adult (50+) population is comprised of three distinct groups: the pre-retired, the active retired and the elders – each group having specific needs. A new ministry is emerging in churches to support the faith development of "maturing adults" throughout the multiple transitions that mark the second half of life.
