Some think that he might be a nobleman who is a Christian. Luke may have seen him as a sponsor for his ministry. Others suggest that he might have been a Roman judge. Luke might have been trying to defend Christianity during a persecution, or perhaps during Paul's trial. Many have the opinion that he is not a specific person because "Theophilus" means "lover of God" in Greek. So, in a way, the book may be commended to all who adore the Lord--all of us. ## 40 Days after Easter

Today the Church celebrates the Ascension of Christ, forty days after Easter. This Holy day commemorates Christ's Ascension into Heaven from Mount Olivet 40 days after He rose from the dead. After the Gospel the Paschal Candle, lit from the New Fire of the Easter Vigil, is extinguished to symbolize the departure of Christ. Christ returns to heaven taking His manhood with Him, and to prepare a place for all His faithful people. It could be said that today marks the beginning of a very solemn period for the Church with a feast ranked as a solemnity celebrated on each of the next four Sundays. After today, which is the Ascension of the Lord, there is Pentecost Sunday on June 9<sup>th</sup>, the Most Holy Trinity on Sunday June 16<sup>th</sup> and the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ on Sunday June 23<sup>rd</sup>.



## The Tabernacle

The Tabernacle of our church is a sacred place. Jesus dwells there in the mystery of the Eucharist. Lighted candles remind us that he is truly present. Catholics show their faith in the "Real Presence" by genuflecting toward the Tabernacle each time they enter or leave the church.
