First Communion and Confirmation @ St. Leo

First Communion for the children of St. Leo's Catholic School will be Sunday, May 3rd 2020 @ 2 pm. First Communion for the children of St. Louis Catholic School will be Sunday May 17th @ 2 pm. Confirmation for both schools will be Sunday April 26th @ 2 pm. All parents/guardians must register their child at the Parish Office in order to request any Sacraments for their child. Registration must be done in person anytime during office hours. The parish office is offering extended office hours on Monday March 30th and Tuesday March 31 office will be open from 9 am until 7 pm. The closing date for registration is Friday, April 17th @ 12 noon. Late registration may mean that child's reception of the Sacraments will be postponed till the following year.

TEN COMMANDEMENTS OF CHURCH MANNERS

1. Arrive on time for the Celebration of Mass.
2. Turn off cellular phones before entering the Church. Do not bring computer games to Church!
3. Do not chew gum in Church. (Communion Fast is one hour prior to receiving Communion.) This includes gum!
4. GENUFLECT: When entering the pew before Mass starts and exiting the pew after Mass has ended. Show respect for the blessed Eucharist present in the Tabernacle.
5. When children are restless, take them to the lobby or to the back of the Church.
6. "Look" to where the action is on the Altar - priest, readers etc.
7. Sing and pray with *ENTHUSIASM!*
8. When receiving Holy Communion, consume the host immediately - do not walk away with it.
9. Remain in your pew until the final procession reaches the back of the Church.
10. After Mass is completed, say a prayer.

Sosthenes, our brother

Paul had come to Corinth after a debacle in Athens. He had been literally laughed out of town the Board of Philosophers, which granted licenses to teach. Discouraged, he traveled about 60 miles away to the city with two ports. Expecting to remain only a few days, he proved such a success that his visit lasted 18 months. It came to a dramatic conclusion when several members of the local Synagogue dragged Paul before a pagan judge. Gallio, the magistrate, refused to listen to the case. So the people from the Synagogue beat up their leader, Sosthenes. The story has a happy ending because Sosthenes becomes one of Paul's co-workers. (Lonsdale Commentaries & Clip Art)
