Lent is all about drawing closer to Jesus. We strongly encourage parishioners to attend daily Mass during Lent. Bring your struggle against sin and personal weakness to the altar and unite it to the Heart of Jesus Christ. Parents, consider bringing your children to morning Mass before school begins. 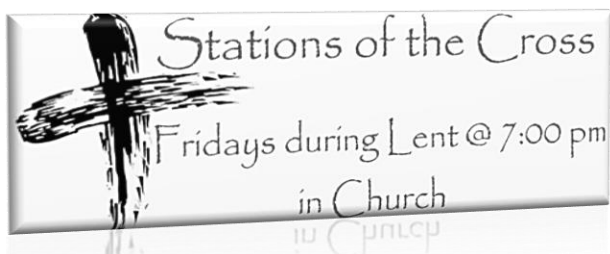
Come One, Come All and Enjoy!
