Perhaps in other parishes the wording vary a bit such as "For Parishioners Intentions" or "For all our Parishioners" or "All the People of the Parish". The pastor in charge of the parish, is obliged to apply a Mass for the people entrusted to him on each Sunday and Holy Day of obligation within his parish boundaries, and that means all the people, not just Catholics, but also for those who have ceased the practice of their religion or have another faith or no faith at all! Hence we ask our parishioner to please request personal mass intentions at any other of our mass celebration. Thank you!
