Support your Parish

To limit the spread of the COVID-19 virus and to adhere to the regulations of the Government of Ontario, all churches in the Archdiocese of Toronto have limited attendance capacity. Our primary concern continues to be the health and well-being of our parishioners, clergy, and staff.

However, the reality is that our parish relies on the support of our parishioners to operate – salaries, programs and ongoing operating costs (heating, water, electricity, etc.) are funded through the generosity of parishioners.

It has been challenging for most parishes to maintain operations without the usual weekly offertory collection. For those attending Mass, please deposit your envelope in the collection basket at the back entrance of the church.

If you are still unable to attend Mass, there are several ways you can continue to support your parish at this time:

- Drop off or mail your regular weekly offertory contribution to the parish office.
- You may want to consider giving electronically instead by visiting the [Donate Now page](#) on the Archdiocese of Toronto website. You will be taken to a page that allows you to choose our parish, and the amount of your gift
- Finally, you can contribute to the offertory via PAG (pre-authorize giving).

PAG allows parishioners to make their regular Sunday offering using the “direct debit” system. When you opt for PAG, your regular Sunday offering is only withdrawn electronically from your account once a month and deposited into the parish account. It’s convenient, simple, and safe and you will be able to support our parish even if you are away by helping us have a stable flow of funding for the parish.
